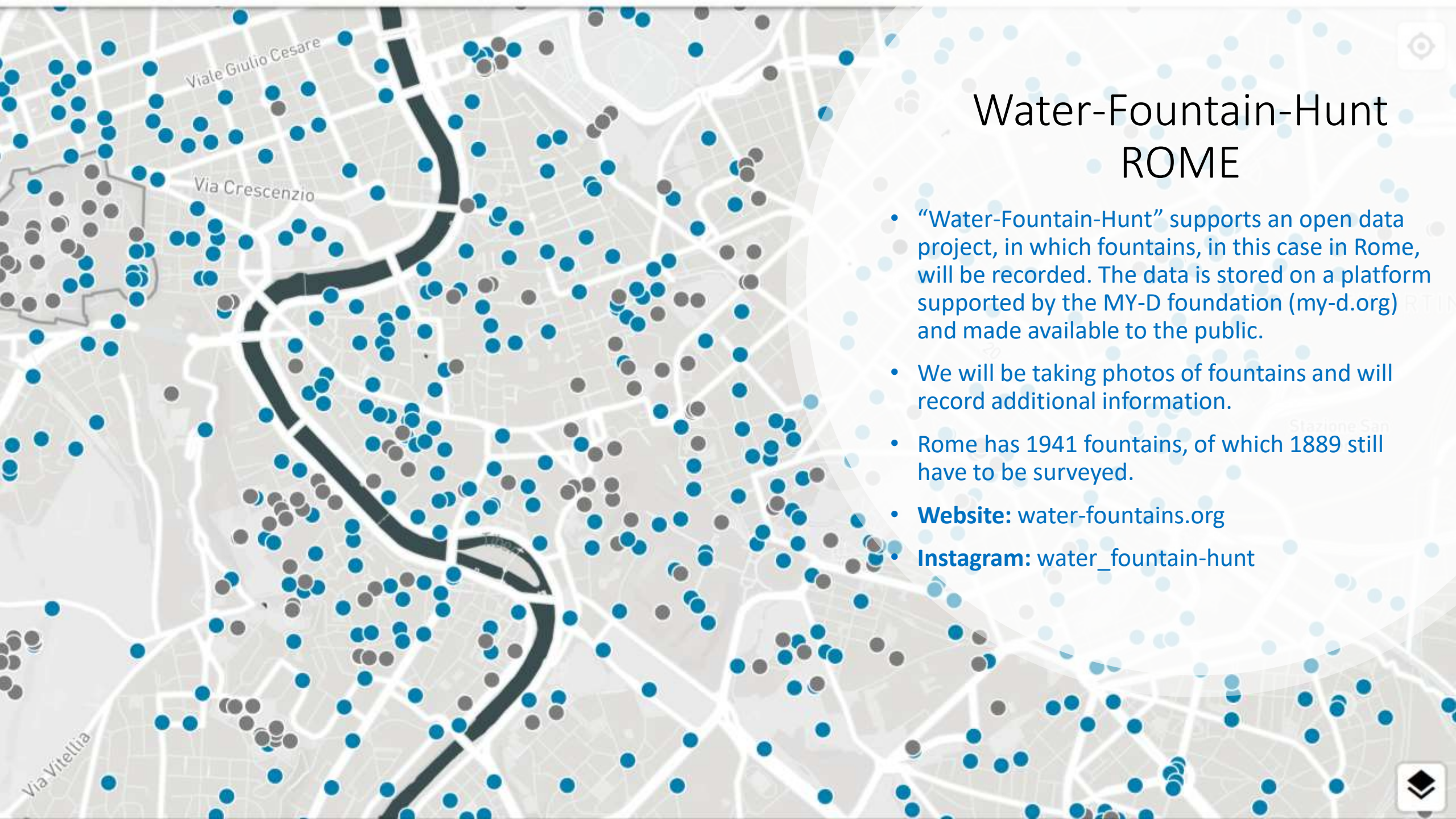

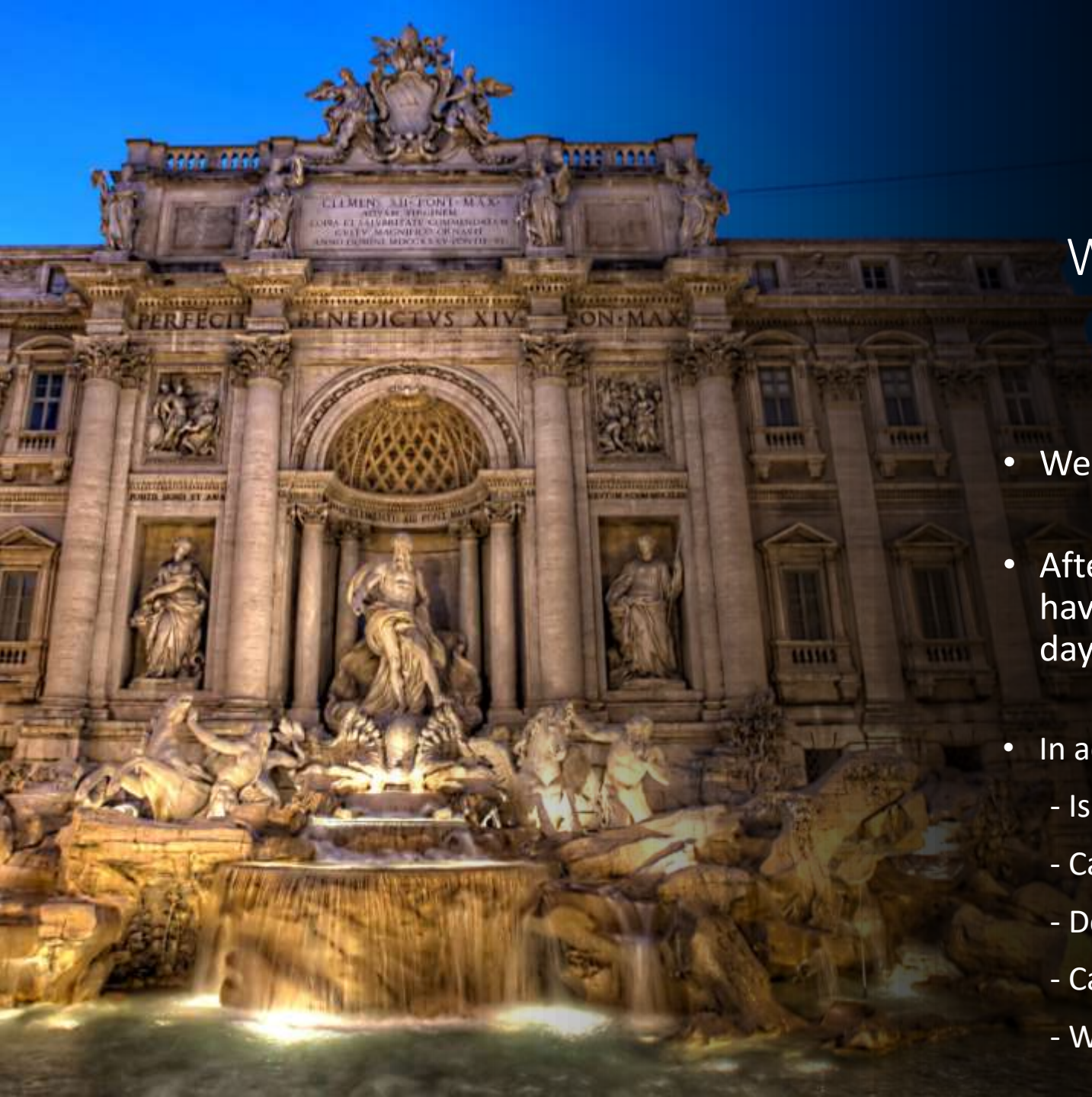
Are you going to join the Water-Fountain-Hunt ROME?

- **When?** April 24th - 26th 2020
- **Where?** Rome
- **What do you need to do?** Organize your travel arrangements to and from Rome, as well as your accommodation
- **Until when do I have to sign up?** 31st of March



Water-Fountain-Hunt ROME

- “Water-Fountain-Hunt” supports an open data project, in which fountains, in this case in Rome, will be recorded. The data is stored on a platform supported by the MY-D foundation (my-d.org) and made available to the public.
- We will be taking photos of fountains and will record additional information.
- Rome has 1941 fountains, of which 1889 still have to be surveyed.

What will you be doing during the Water-Fountain Hunt?

- We divide into groups
- After you'll receive a list of fountains which you will have to find, record and photograph (3 to 4 hours each day)
- In addition, you will verify the following details:
 - Is the fountain wheelchair accessible? Yes / No
 - Can you fill a drinking bottle? Yes / No
 - Does the fountain have a trough for dogs? Yes / No
 - Can you bathe in the fountain? Yes / No
 - What material is the fountain made of? wood/stone/metal
